

The meeting of the Sullivan County Commissioners was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on the above date by Chair Darlene Fenton. Attending were Commissioner Darlene Fenton, Commissioner Donna Iannone, Commissioner Brian Hoffman, Chief Clerk Hope Verelst, Solicitor Kenneth Levitzky, Sheriff Bob Montgomery, and Coroner Wendy Hastings.

Those present recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag.

Commissioner Hoffman made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 6, 2022, Commissioners' Meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Iannone and unanimously approved.

Commissioner Iannone made a motion to set annual salary increases for elected Row Officers as follows: 2024-3%, 2025-2%, 2026-3%, 2027-2%. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Fenton and unanimously approved.

Commissioner Iannone made a motion to stagnate the salary of the Prothonotary, should the sitting Prothonotary be re-elected in 2023, at \$58,317.04 until it aligns with the \$2,000.00 additional allowed by statute. This is to correct a calculation error in the Prothonotary's salary dating back to 1988. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hoffman and unanimously approved.

There being no additional business to discuss, Commissioner Fenton made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:03 p.m.
